

# IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL DOG AND CAT OWNERS!

The Animal Overpopulation Ordinances recently approved by the Sacramento City Council and the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors include the following changes:

- ✓ **Moderate pet licensing fee increases for altered pets and substantially higher fees for dogs and cats who are not spayed or neutered (see below for rates)**
- ✓ **Cat licensing required for city residents**
- ✓ **Registered “show or competition animals” (and ranch dogs in the county) qualify for lower fees for unaltered pets, if they meet specific requirements**
